DESIGN GUIDELINES, TOOLS + PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT | As cofounder of the Portland Main Streets Design Initiative, Heather brings her planning expertise to engage neighborhoods, business districts, community groups, design professionals, students, and policymakers to foster community visioning, policy advocacy, art, innovative public engagement, and tools to guide growth and change, including two sets of main street design guidelines, adopted for eight main streets in Portland.

GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE PLANNING + COMMUNICATION | As Manager of the Green Futures Research + Design Lab, Heather Flint Chatto was part of the design team to coordinate public engagement for the development of the City of Lake Forest Park 100 Year Legacy Plan including a green infrastructure community open house and festival, community charette, and analysis of community surveys. Forage is currently developing a Strategic Communications Roadmap for planning and culturally sensitive public engagement with Levee Ready Columbia.
